3. Matters Arising

a) SDC Local Plan Review – Feedback on Youth Consultation Report

Members agreed this report covered the workshop well and endorsed its production with the following additions; add who members represent on SDYC, amend Tom Wickham Bassett's and add on SDYC Logo and overview statement from Chair (Rebecca).

b) SDC Youth Voice Representative Survey 2017/18 – Live participation update

Members asked for details of comments and asked how they would be acted upon by staff. Steve, Jemma and Rachael will collate responses, consider along side the annual review outcomes and share with new leadership team.

c) NHS Gloucestershire CCG – Online Counseling Service Commissioning Panel Feedback

George gave an overview of purposes of the panel. Really good experience, made to feel very welcome and comfortable. The panel were clearly taken very seriously and response from commissioners was that they were hugely grateful and very impressed by the work of the panel.

d) Mental Health First Aid Training Opportunity – confirm interest and program

Phil Matthews (from ACE wellbeing) gave a brief overview of how he delivers mental health first aid training. He gave a brief overview of the training content and talked about taking the official mental health first aid accredited training content and tailor it for SDYC. Ideal timings were discussed. 4. Correspondence

#IWill - Youth Social Action Event

SDYC has been invited to a 'countywide conversation' on the benefits of youth social action with other organisations on 19 April 6:30pm to 8:30pm, at The Pavilion, Up Hatherley, Cheltenham. The background to the #iwill Campaign in Gloucestershire includes; Gloucestershire Community Foundation's launch of the program last year by awarding a grant to 6 delivery organisations: Creative Sustainability CIC; Gloucestershire Young Carers; Hopes Children and Young Peoples Support; Venture White City; Youth and Community Services; and Young Gloucestershire. The whole project includes: a forum for young carers aged 11 – 20 years; an environmental and climate change youth forum in Stroud; and a youth advisory board.

Healthwatch Gloucestershire - Survey to set local priorities

Recent communication with Healthwatch Gloucestershire followed a consultation on their priorities. Steve is meeting them soon to see how young people can have an input and maybe future engagement with SDYC.
