3. Local Democracy Focus Group Report from meeting on 28 February

<u>Statutory Youth Voice – develop a draft structure:</u> The group reflected on the previous meetings report and acknowledged the decisions made at the last SDYC Main Group Meeting.

The group feel the following should be included as essential resources for a youth voice model:

- Young people identify age range; determine if its paid or voluntary involvement
- Youth workers qualified and experienced
- Transport access to vehicles
- Meeting space appropriate for the purpose
- Youth voice training various programmes required
- Communication and facilitation hardware and software
- Administration systems
- Refreshments for youth voice activities, events, and meetings
- Relationships with adult decision-making processes
- Internal reviews carried out by young people on programmes and impact
- Adherence to Hear by Right (national standards for youth participation) and its award programme

Members were asked to consider the following recommendation: That the list of essential resources drafted in this meeting, evolved into a formal checklist, and becomes part of the project / campaign.
